Ayah 10

- 3. and when he is trusted he betrays.**

HADITH

'Abdullah bin Az-Zubair said that a group of riders belonging to Banu Tamim came to the Prophet, Abu Bakr said (to the Prophet), **"Appoint Al-Qa'qa bin Mabad bin Zurara as (their) ruler."** 'Umar said (to the Prophet). **"No! But appoint Al-Aqra bin Habis."** Thereupon Abu Bakr said (to 'Umar). **"You just wanted to oppose me."** 'Umar replied. **"I did not want to oppose you."** So both of them argued so much that their voices became louder, and then the following Divine Verses were revealed in that connection:-- "O you who have believed, do not put [yourselves] before **All?h** and His Messenger but fear **All?h....**" (till the end of Verse)...(49.1) (Book #59, Hadith #653). `Abdullah bin Az-Zubayr said, "After that, `Umar's voice was so low that the Messenger of Allah had to ask him to repeat what he said so that he could understand what he was saying to him."
